

The Slicker than Snot Scarf

*Slicker Than Snot
Cascade Copa
With keyhole option*



Yarn Cascade Copa
100% Viscose, 50g/137 yds
Uses 2 rolls
--OR--
Noro Kureyon Sock
70% Wool, 30% Nylon, 100g/420m
Uses approx 60g

Needles US 3 (3.25mm) - for Copa Version
US 5 (3.75 mm) - for Kureyon Sock (Not Quite So Slick version)

Gauge Not important (it's a scarf, for heaven's sake!)

Seed stitch If you don't know how, look it up.

Pattern Row (both right and wrong sides):
*k1, yo, k2tog, repeat from * to end

Begin Scarf

Copa - Cast on 36 stitches.

Kureyon Sock - Cast on 42 stitches.

Work in seed stitch for 2 inches.

Work in Pattern Row for 32 inches.

Keyhole (optional)

Note: We did not work a keyhole in the Kureyon Sample shown.

Divide work thus:

Work pattern for 18 stitches, slip remaining 18 stitches onto stitch holder. Working on first set of stitches, work Pattern Row for 3 inches, ending at middle of work. Slip the 18 stitches just worked onto stitch holder and break yarn.

Place first set of 18 stitches from holder onto needle and work for 3 inches, ending at outside edge of work.

Turn work and knit across first 18 and then across 18 stitches from holder. 36 stitches now on needle.

Continue until entire scarf measures 40 inches from beginning, or until you lose your mind.

End scarf

Work 2 inches seed stitch, bind off and weave in ends.

Wear and receive scads of compliments.
