

Double-Wrap Stitch Scarf



Materials needed:

US Size 8 Needle

2 skeins Berroco Bonsai (97% Bamboo, 3% Nylon, 50g/77yds)

Cast on 27 stitches

Double-wrap stitch:

Insert needle into next stitch as if to knit.

Wrap working yarn around both needles, then around right needle only.

Knit, dropping worked stitch and wrap off of left needle.

Begin Scarf

Knit 12 rows garter stitch (slipping 1st stitch knitwise on each row)

Next row: double-wrap stitch each stitch across

Next 2 rows: slip k-wise, knit to end

Repeat last three rows (double-wrap row, knit row, knit row)

Finish double-wrap pattern, ending on 1st row (double-wrap row)

Knit 12 rows garter stitch

Finish by weaving in ends and blocking gently (steam with iron, protected by towel.)

Our scarf of 47" long was approximately 57 repeats of the three-row pattern. Approximately.

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
